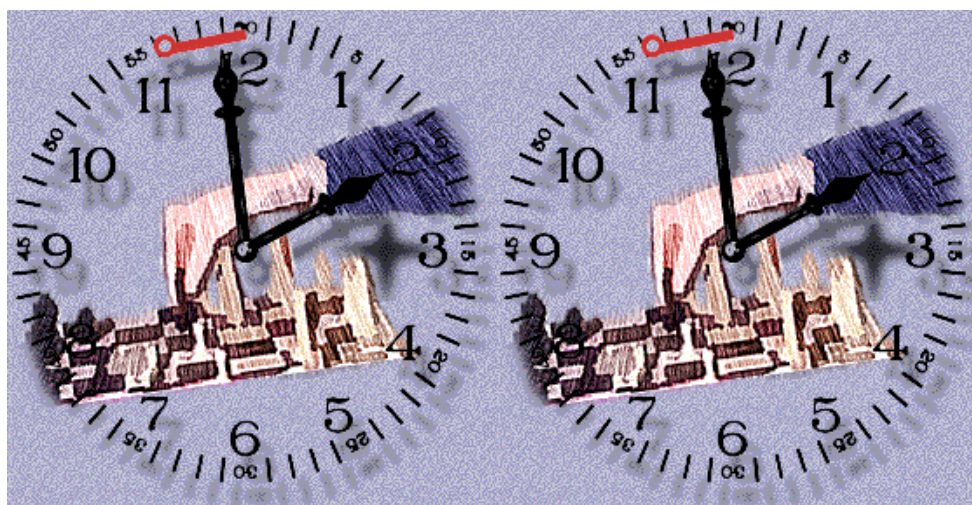


London Civil Service, Post Office and Municipal Chess League INDIVIDUAL BLITZ OPEN & U-150 TOURNAMENTS

Format

- ♦ Open and U-150 Tournaments
- ♦ ECF 2011 grades will be used
- ♦ All-play-all or Swiss System, number of rounds dependent on entry, but will finish by 9.30pm approx.
- ♦ 5 minutes per player per game
- ♦ FIDE Blitz rules apply

Prizes

- ♦ Winner of the Open to hold the Bond Trophy for one year and receive an engraved tankard
- ♦ U-150 Winner to receive a tankard
- ♦ 2010 winners were: Open, Jim Robinson (GLCC); U-150, Peter Biggs (HOJCC)

Entry

- ♦ The tournament is open to all LCSPOM Chess League players
- ♦ Civil servants new to the League are welcome but must first join their departmental club (see <http://www.cscl.org.uk> for a list of clubs)
- ♦ **Entry is £3 per player**, payable on the evening of the tournament. *(Since the closure of the Chadwick Street venue it is necessary to introduce a small charge for blitz events this season)*
- ♦ All entries to be notified to the tournament controller by Sunday 25th September, indicating which tournament (Open, U-150) you wish to enter
- ♦ Entries will be acknowledged by email
